## **Questions to Ask a Potential Service Provider**

## **Pricing and Charges:**

- 1. What type of pricing structure do you offer? Fixed or variable?
- 2. If variable, how will the price be determined?
- 3. If fixed, are there PJM pass-throughs in addition to my fixed price such as ancillary service or open access transmission charges?
- 4. Are there any maximum charges to mitigate price volatility for variable rates? If yes, can you please provide an example?
- 5. What is the price per kilowatt hour that I can compare to APCo's rate schedules and what future rate increases are you assuming for APCO?
- 6. Does APCo's FRR rate charge apply to you? If so, will that be passed through to me?
- 7. Are there demand charges? If so, how are they determined?
- 8. Are there any time of use restrictions or incentives?
- 9. Are there any choices of energy sources, such as green or renewable energy?

## **Contract Provisions:**

- 10. Are there any options for contract length? Do you offer contracts that cover the minimum 5 year stay out provision under Virginia law?
- 11. Are there any minimum or maximum usage provisions in the contract? If so, what are the related charges?
- 12. Are there any savings guarantees? If so, how will any potential credits be calculated?
- 13. What are the cancellation or early termination charges? Are they time sensitive?
- 14. Under what circumstances can you cancel my contract?
- 15. What happens at the end of the contract term? Does it automatically renew?

## **Billing & Other:**

- 16. Will I be billed from actual metered usage, or will my initial bill be based upon PJM initial settlement values derived from forecasted LSE load?
- 17. Can we be made to pay as we go weekly if PJM is charging our supplier in this fashion?
- 18. What procedures are in place if I have a question or a complaint with you as my supplier?
- 19. Will I be refunded for settlement errors found after the PJM 60 day final true up, like regulated tariffs require?
- 20. What are the late payment provisions?
- 21. Is a security deposit, collateral or other initial fees required?
